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Community engagement is all about achieving an outcome on the ground. There are so many different perspectives, perspective of the people on the ground, then there's researchers, there's local governments, there's state governments, there's industry groups, all these people trying to influence the land managers on the ground of the best ways to do this.

So if I can get the perspectives of all of those researchers, Governments, industry groups, bring that to the landholders, and develop ownership from everybody, then we can achieve something on ground to address that issue.

It's a part of the way your operate. It needs to be the way that you work with people. You have to listen. It comes back to that topic of ownership, that if you can have people on board, discussing things, agreeing, listening, having an open mind, then you can work together to develop a plan that hopefully you can achieve something.
